**Introduction**

The Guruvayoor Campus came into being on 16-07-1979 consequent on the takeover of an institution then known as GuruvayoorSahityaDeepika Sanskrit Vidyapeetha at Pavaratty near Guruvayoor, founded by Late Sri. P.T. Kuriakkose Master. The erstwhile Vidyapeetha had attained fame in and outside the state of Kerala as a centre of Sanskrit Learning imparting instruction at graduate and postgraduate level with affiliation to Madras University in 1934, Kerala University in 1958 and Calicut University in 1968. This abode of ancient traditional studies got affiliation with Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan under Ministry of H.R.D. Govt. of India, with effect from January 1972.

The Guruvayoor Campus has twocentres, one at Puranattukara and one at Pavaratty.

Centre at Puranattukara is the main centre which situates on a beautiful landscape of an extent of fourteen acres. It comprises of Main Academic block, Administrative block, Boys & Girls Hostel for an accommodation of 120 students each, Library, Guest House, Auditorium, Play Ground, Semi functional building and quarters.

Centre at Pavaratty situates on a land of extent of 50 cents. This centre is renamed as P.T. KuriakkoseSmrithiBhawan. There is a single storied building having two big halls, one administrative room and ten class rooms with all modern amenities.

**Library :**

Library has Computers which are connected to broadband Internet. There is a Photocopying machine and computer printer. The library has a Sales & Purchase Committee, which acquires books for the General Library. The selection of current titles and other reading materials is made by subject specialists of the individual departments. All research scholars of campus and from other institutions use them. The Library offers internet services to students and staff. There are no specified hours for internet usage in the library. However, students are encouraged to use the internet facilities during lunch hours and other non-class hours. The library services are computerized. The institution use software designed and trained by the NIC. More than 30000 books are in stock on different subjects and 250 manuscripts are stored with safe.

## Computer Lab, Language Lab. and Linguistic Lab.

Institution is having a computer lab with 15 computers. The qualified and experienced staff maintains the systems and provides technical assistance to the faculty members and students. Internet facility is available always. The facility of the Central Processing Unit will be provided soon, as the work is in progress.

## Campus Location

1. Puranattukara Main Campus, Guruvayoor Campus is situated in an educational complex area in Adat Panchayath in Thrissur District, Kerala with Amala Medical college, Ramakrishna Ashramam Gurukulam school, IES Engineering college, Sarada Girls High School, Kendriya Vidyalaya and so on. From Thrissur Town, Guruvayoor Campus is 8 kilometers to North West. The Kochi international airport at Nedumbassery is only sixty one kilometers away from the campus, along the Adat Muthuvara, Thrissur, Ernakulam National High Way – NH 47.
2. Kuriakkose Master Smrithi Bhavan at Pavaratty. (Fifteen kilometers away from the main centre)

## Courses Offered

At present the campus at Puranattukara offers courses like Prakshastry (Intermediate), Shastry (Graduation), Acharya (Post-Graduation) in Vedanta, Sahitya, Vyakarana, Nyaya, Jyotisha, Siksha Shastry (B.Ed.) and Ph.D. (Vidyavaridhi). The campus offers modern subjects such as English, History, Malayalam, Computer Science, Yoga, Environmental Studies and special English to prepare the students to be in tune with modern world.
