#### **ANNUAL REPORT 2017-18**

#### 1. ABOUT THE CAMPUS:

Kerala, the God's own Country, sanctified with the birth of Adi Sankara, is exalted to the pinnacle as a place of living without discrimination of caste, colour, gender and creed as influenced by Adi Guru Shri Shankaracharya's philosophy of Advaita Vedanta.

Samskritapranayabhajanam P.T.Kuriyakkose Master started Guruvayoor Sahitya Deepika Sanskrit Vidyapeetha at Pavaratty in 1909 in this true inspirational spirit. He devoted his life and donated his entire wealth for the propagation of Sanskrit Language. In 1934, he started U.G. and P.G. Courses in Sanskrit under Madras University. It was affiliated to Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan in 1972 and named as Sahitya Deepika Sanskrit Vidyapeetha.

The institution was taken over by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, under MHRD, Govt. of India on 16<sup>th</sup> July 1979 and renamed it as Guruvayoor Kendriya Sanskrit Vidhyapeetha. It was shifted to Puranattukara from Pavaratty in 1983 for better Infrastructural and Academic facilities.

The New Administrative and Academic block located at Puranattukara was inaugurated by Dr. Murali Manohar Joshi , the then Hon'ble HRD Minister, on 16<sup>th</sup> August 1998.

Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan was raised to the status of a multi campus Deemed University and this institution was renamed as Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Guruvayoor Campus on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2002.

It is located at Puranattukara in Adat Panchayat in Thrissur District just behind Sarada Girls High School. It is flanked by Amala Institute Medical Sciences, Ramakrishna Ashramam Gurukulam Schools, IES Engineering College and Kendriya Vidyalaya. It is 8km away from Thrissur on NH 47. The nearest airport is at Kochi, Nedumbassery.
