- An internal committee should be formed for documentation and assessment.

- Monthly meetings of IQAC should be conducted as per the Academic Calendar.
- For the smooth and timely IQAC activities infrastructural facilities are essential. Such as Computer, Colour Printer, Scanner.
- ICT enabled mini conference room has to be provided.
- We have to update our present conference hall equipped with Computer, Mike System and Projector Screens.
- Renovation of the smart classroom, Language Lab, tow Computer Labs and Psychology Lab.
- Disabled-friendly restrooms must be constructed, the campus must be smoke-free, waste management must be implemented, the biogas system must be updated (we must obtain a receipt from the panchayath for waste management), wet waste and paper waste must be disposed of in RED and GREEN Bins, waste water must be recycled, and a pedestrian path with a chain must be constructed from the main building. Installation of solar panels and Rainwater harvesting facility have to be made.
- A list of all necessary equipment for the campus should be created and forwarded to the Head office for necessary action.
- We must include Sookhna Boards in Sarala Manaka Samskritam. The entrance board, map at the entrance, and instructions to turn off cell phones can be added in Saralamanak Samskrit. We should also add names to each block, such as academic buildings, hostels. and new blocks. The old Shikasha Shastra building and auditorium must be resurrected and put to new use.
- We must give special focus on academics and research.
- Library resources may be enhanced.
- The library should give students access to search and choose books.
- We should prepare the academic schedule.

- Students' welfare council (SWC) should be started as soon as the academic year 2022–2023 gets underway.
- Training programs should be offered, for instance on NEP awareness, Preparing a Research article, NAAC Awareness, CAS Awareness, Spoken Sanskrit for teaching and non-teaching staff. Also training sessions must be conducted for students to prepare for the All India competitions.
- Alumni association should be launched on our campus. The registration fee of Rs. 100 shall be mandatorily collected from the students before issuing No Dues certificates.
- The students should be asked to submit a copy of all their certificates to the IQAC for the documentation purpose.
- For each academic year, CSU scholarships will be routinely documented.
- **More teaching and non-teaching staff recruitment is urgently needed.**
- Extra vehicle parking space should be set up.
- All Guruvayoor Camps committees must be under the supervision of IQAC. Minutes and progress reports of all committees should be submitted to the IQAC before the end of the Academic year.
- To oversee the wellbeing of all employees, a separate staff welfare committee must be established.
- IQAC shall form various subcommittees whenever they are necessary.
- For a minimum of five days, IQAC can provide professional development programmes for all teaching and non-teaching employees. The best time to hold FDPs, workshops, and other events will be during the breaks leading up to exams.
- For the teaching and non-teaching employees who do not have a Sanskrit background, it can also arrange language camps or spoken Sanskrit classes.
- Additionally, it develops and puts into practice some simple standard Sanskrit administration and management procedures for the campus.
- IQAC may advise all HODs on how to obtain funds and grants from non-governmental organizations -NGOs or any Individual. For this purpose an endowment portal maybe created.
- We can add all of our programmes to an official YouTube account that our university's administration can appropriately manage. We need a separate digital camera in order to maintain accuracy and high quality of videos.
- Additionally, Librarian and the DDE campus in charge may be invited to future IQAC meetings.

The meeting came to an end with the Vote of thanks by Prof. K. K. Shine. Shanti Mantra was recited.

  - f) Record of Facilities available for divyanga janas in each campus. - **This may be uploaded in Campus Website.**
  - g) Cleanliness of toilets - **CPWD may complete the work as the amount is transferred for the same. The competent authorities will conduct an urgent meeting for immediate action.**
  - h) Cleanliness of playground - **Already cleaned the play ground, but need to be Maintained.**
  - i) Boards of various Cells (with the names of committee members) - **A committee has constituted and Rs.30,000/- sanctioned.**
  - j) Facilities available for internet/wifi connection in computer labs/other labs and in all departments of campus. - **Connected but Upgradation is required.**
  - k) Maintained Smart Classrooms - **More classes may be added.**
  - l) Citizen charter in each campus. - **A committee may be constituted for this.**
  - m) Boards of RTI Information officer and Appellate authority in each campus. - **A committee may be constituted for this.**
  - n) Boards of Grievance committee in each campus. - **Already Constituted a Grievance Cell.**
  - o) Information about neatness of various Centres such as MRC, MCC etc.-
  - p) Maintained auditorium or big halls in campuses - **Maintenance work may be started soon.**

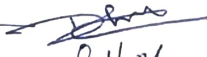

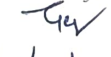
