**ORDER**

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution **Rashtriya Sankrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur-680551, Kerala** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one basic unit in B.Ed.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following condition namely,

- (ii) The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition **Rashtriya Sankrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur-680551, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of **two years** duration with an annual intake of **50 students** one basic unit from the academic session **2015-16** subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.

8. The institution shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-



**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, Thrissur Dist, Kerala-680551** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/2333 dated **09.08.2005** for conducting **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated **19.01.2015**.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on **15.05.2015** for conducting **B.Ed.** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50** students (**one basic units**) from the academic session **2015-2016**.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 381<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> October & 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2020 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on **15.09.2020** to reply within 21 days. The institution vide letter dated **04.11.2020** submitted reply to Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-*

*On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, Thrissur Dist, Kerala-680551** for B.Ed programme for **1 basic unit of 50 students.**"*

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, Survey No. 61 Dist, Kerala-680551** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one basic units)** subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme (s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned.
